Electrical engineer/ Mechanical engineer

- **Electrical engineer:**

- a field of engineering that generally deals with the design, development, testing and maintenance of electrical systems, components and equipment
- qualifications: BSc or MSc
- acquired knowledge: electronics, informatics, project management skills
- an independent training



- **Mechanical engineer:**

- the branch of engineering that deals with the design, production and operation of machinery.
- qualifications: BSc or MSc
- acquired knowledge: technical drawing, project management skills, design

IT consultant/Teacher

- **IT consultant:**

- their field of activity focuses on advising organizations to use information technology in achieving their business goals
- qualifications: BSc or MSc
- Acquired skills: business, communication, management, and technical language



- **Teacher:**

- both at junior (10-14 years) and secondary education (15-18 years)
- shortage of IT, Maths, Physics, and Chemistry teachers
- qualifications: MSc or BSc degree



Financial Advisor

- a professional who renders financial services to clients
- duties: financial services, writing contracts
- qualifications: MSc or MBA degree, NQR (National Qualifications Register) diploma

Electrician

- a tradesperson who specializes in electrical wiring of buildings, machines, and related equipment
- the work is physically demanding (climbing ladders, lifting heavy tools and supplies)
- qualifications: NQR diploma

Bricklayer/ Joiner/ Carpenter

- **Bricklayer (mason):**

- a craftsman who lays bricks to construct buildings
- qualifications: NQR diploma

- **Joiner/ Carpenter:**

- cuts and fits joints in wood without the use of nails, screws or other metal fasteners
- qualifications: NQR diploma
- joiners prepare furniture, doors, windows, and
- carpenters construct woodwork of buildings and



Doctor/Nurse

- **Doctor:**

- especially surgeons and anesthesiologists
- qualifications: medical university degree

- **Nurse:**

- qualifications: degree or diploma
- if you have a degree you can be a nurse practitioner



Accountant/Chartered accountant

- works in all fields of business and finance, including audit, taxation, financial, and general management
- qualifications: NQR diploma, finance and accounting or economic degree
- if you are a chartered accountant you can have your own accountant business
