A Clinical Research Associate (CRA, also called a clinical monitor or trial monitor) is a health-care professional who performs many activities related to medical research, particularly clinical trial. A Clinical Research Associate works in various settings, such as pharmaceutical companies, medical research institutes and government agencies.




BIOMEDICAL ENGINEER (BME)

Biomedical engineer (BME) is the application of engineering principles and design concepts to medicine and biology for healthcare purposes (e.g. diagnostic or therapeutic). It combines the design and problem solving skills of engineering with medical and biological sciences to advance health care treatment, including diagnosis, monitoring, and therapy.



ACTUARY

An actuary is a business professional who deals with the measurement and management of risk and uncertainty. Actuaries accurately price property insurance, set appropriate reserves, and design appropriate reinsurance and capital management strategies.



DENTAL HYGIENIST

A dental hygienist is a medical specialist who performs minor dental surgeries and hygienic actions under the supervision of a doctor.




ROOM ACOUSTIC

Room acoustics work on how sound behaves in an enclosed space. Architectural acoustics can be about achieving enhancing the quality of music in a concert hall or recording studio but room acoustics suppress noise to make offices and conference rooms more productive and pleasant places to work in.



AUDIOLOGIST

Audiology is a branch of science that studies hearing, balance, and related disorders. Audiologists who treat those with hearing loss and proactively prevent related damage are audiologists.



PERSONAL TRAINER

A personal trainer is a fitness professional involved in exercise prescription and instruction.

They motivate clients by setting goals and providing feedback and accountability to clients.

Trainers also measure their client's strengths and weaknesses with fitness assessments.



BIOTECHNOLOGIST

Biotechnologists use living systems and organisms to develop or make products, or "any technological application that uses biological systems, living organisms or derivatives to make or modify products or processes for specific use".



PLUMBER

A plumber is a tradesperson who specializes in installing and maintaining systems used for potable (drinking) water and drainage in plumbing systems.



ELECTRICIAN

An electrician is a tradesperson specializing in electrical wiring of buildings, stationary machines and related equipment. Electricians may be employed in the installation of new electrical components or the maintenance and repair of existing electrical infrastructure.



WELDER

A welder or welder operator is a tradesperson who specializes in welding materials together. The term welder refers to the operator, the machine is referred to as the welding power supply.



TAILOR

A tailor is a tradesperson who makes, repairs, or alters clothing professionally, especially suits and men's clothing.



TILER

A tiler is a tradesman who occupies in manufacturing pieces of hard-wearing material such as ceramic, stone, metal or glass, generally used for covering roofs, floors, walls, showers.



SINGER

A singer is a person who sings songs.




